NEW YORK, Oct. 8.—Prices made further recovery today from their abrupt declines of Wednesday, under evidence of the railways, which governed the market from start to finish.

Specialties opened strong, Westinghouse, Crucible, Colgate and Baldwin Locomotive recording advances of 1 to 3 points.

Total sales of stocks amounted to 1,200,000 shares, making the tenth successive full session in which dealing has approximated that amount.
