Canadian Officials Committed for Trial

WINNIPEG, Manitoba, Oct. 9.—Sir Rodmond Roblin, late premier, and three other former cabinet ministers, Dr. Montague, J. H. Howden and G. P. Colwell, were committed for trial this afternoon by Magistrate McDonald on a charge of conspiracy to defraud the province in connection with the erection of the parliament buildings. Dr. Montague was minister of public works; Howden, attorney general, and Mr. Colwell, minister of education. DISBARMENT PROCEEDINGS AGAINST KIRBY DISMISSED. PIERRE, S. D., Oct. 9.—(Special Telegram.)—In the opinion of the supreme court today in the disbarment proceedings against Joe Kirby, a prominent St. Paul attorney, the court in its findings says: "Believing that the misconduct of which defendant stands charged does not when considered alone show the defendant so unfitted to be an attorney of this court as would authorize a judgment of disbarment; believing that in all else, save perhaps that one matter in respect to which he seems to be suffering an illusion, defendant will hereafter act to the credit of his profession; believing that suspension of his right as an attorney would not hasten the time of his disbarment, the only fact that could warrant such suspension and believing that the public, whose servants we are and whose destinies we seek to protect, will approve of giving to the defendant the benefit of any doubt we may have as to what our judgment should be, we are of the opinion the disbarment proceedings should be dismissed."
