FUNSTON WILL NOT LEAD EXPEDITION

War Department Instructs Major General He Is Not to Command Troops in Person.

CENSORSHIP IS ESTABLISHED

SAN ANTONIO, Tex., March 12.—Instructed by the War department at Washington that he was not personally to command the troops that will cross the Rio Grande into Mexico to search for Francisco Villa...

That an officer subordinate to him, a brigadier general, would command the punitive expedition.

That this officer would have complete charge in the field and would not be hampered by unnecessary instructions.

That it would take two or three days to organize the force or forces that will go in pursuit of Villa.

That the First Aero Squadron, stationed at Fort Sam Houston, will be a part of the expeditionary forces.

That a close watch will be kept at all border points for any symptoms of disorder that will necessitate the movement of troops.

General Funston, for military reasons, refused to state how large the expeditionary force would be...

Other members are Captain T. T. Dodd and Lieutenants H. A. Dargue, W. G. Gorrell, W. G. Kilmer and R. H. Willis.
