Remodeled Crounse Block is Occupied by Some Real Live Up-to-Date Merchants



Under the direction of Conrad Young, manager of the Nebraska and Wyoming Investment company, the Crounse building at Sixteenth and Capitol avenue, opposite the postoffice, has been remodeled at a cost of \$75,000. As completed this building is a credit to growing Omaha and to the firms that occupy it.

The storerooms on the ground floor are now among the most modern in the city. The second and third floors are arranged into steam heated, electric lighted offices and lodge rooms.

Some of the firms occupying ground floor storerooms have been in their present location a great many years and have long felt the need for more commodious quarters and modern conveniences.

For twenty years Stewart's Seed store has been located in this building—three times have they increased their space, and now they have the best appointed seed and poultry supply salesrooms in the west. This firm also does a large mail order business on all kinds of seeds, garden implements, poultry feeds, and supplies, bulbs and plants. Locally they do a considerable business in cut flowers.

The Douglas Shoe store, operated by W. S. Stryker, now has three times as much space as formerly. New fixtures have been installed throughout, giving an excellent display in this "daylight store." This store has operated for twenty-two years and recently, through specializing in "foot troubles," has built a remarkable trade. Stryker's slogan, "Put your feet in Stryker's hands for foot comfort service," gives a good idea of the endeavors of this store to serve. The enlarged room, ventilating system, new fixtures and new stock makes the Douglas Shoe store one of the best in the state.

The Boston Meat and Grocery company has been established in one location for sixteen years. Under the direction of Jacob Sloburg, Jr., it has developed into one of the important business concerns of Omaha. Through specializing in mail orders a state-wide trade has been built up of remarkable proportions. The remodeling of their quarters gives this prosperous business double their former space. A modern bakery and fruit stor has been added.

Cackley Bros. have been established twenty-five years. Their business has been built on standard brands of liquors of known quality. These people have a saying, "If you can't find it here it can't be found, or isn't worth handling." Their stock consists of all the wines and liquors, olives, olive oils, including the imported stock, known to the public and the trade. The new storeroom, with its handsome fixtures, gives these people a store that is not surpassed in any western city.
