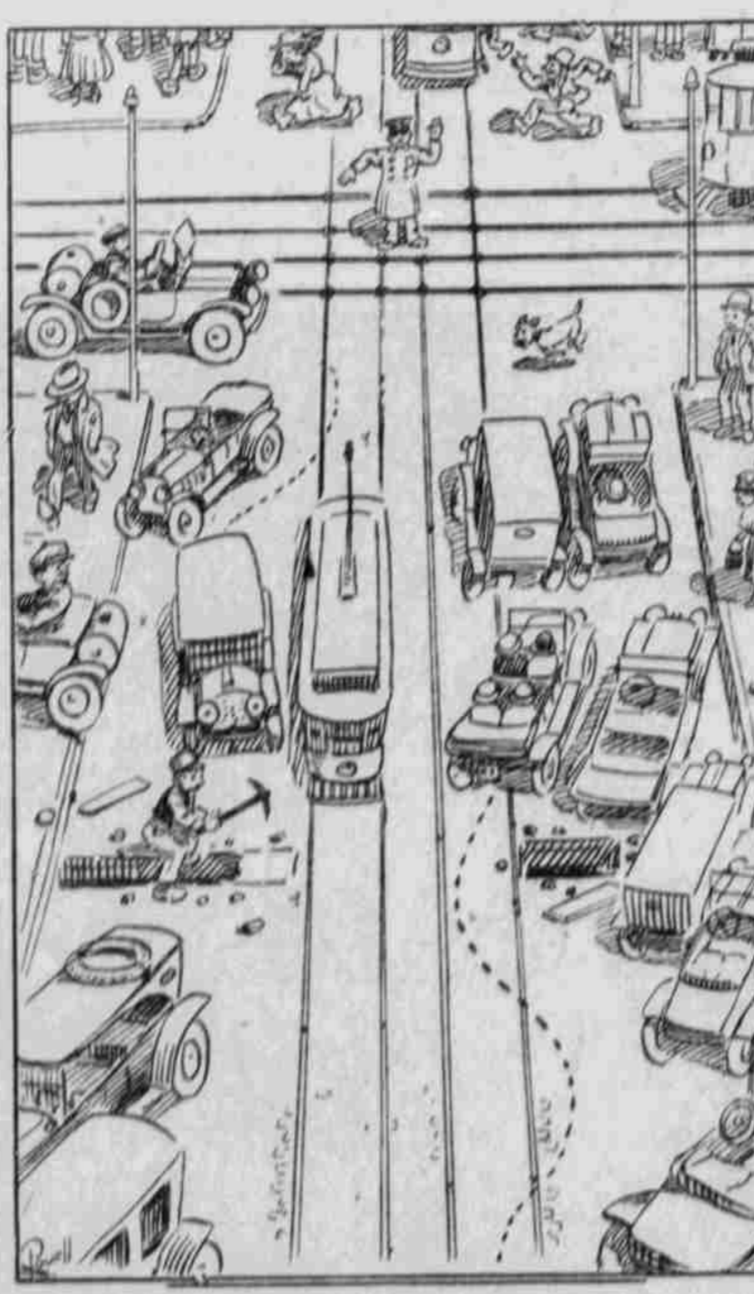
CONVICTS TRY TO LYNCH BISSELL
