Will Be Ready for it When it Comes and Has Plans Matured for Eventualities.

U. S. SENDS RANGE FINDERS

LINCOLN, May 9.—(Special.)—The conditions in Mexico and the information contained in noon papers that President Wilson would call out the state militia of three border states to patrol the border has lived up to things considerably at National Guard headquarters today.

The arrival yesterday of two range finders, one each for the two Nebraska regiments, indicates there is a possibility that instead of going to Fort Robinson for summer maneuvers the Nebraska Guard may be sent to the south as to be in closer communication with the border.
