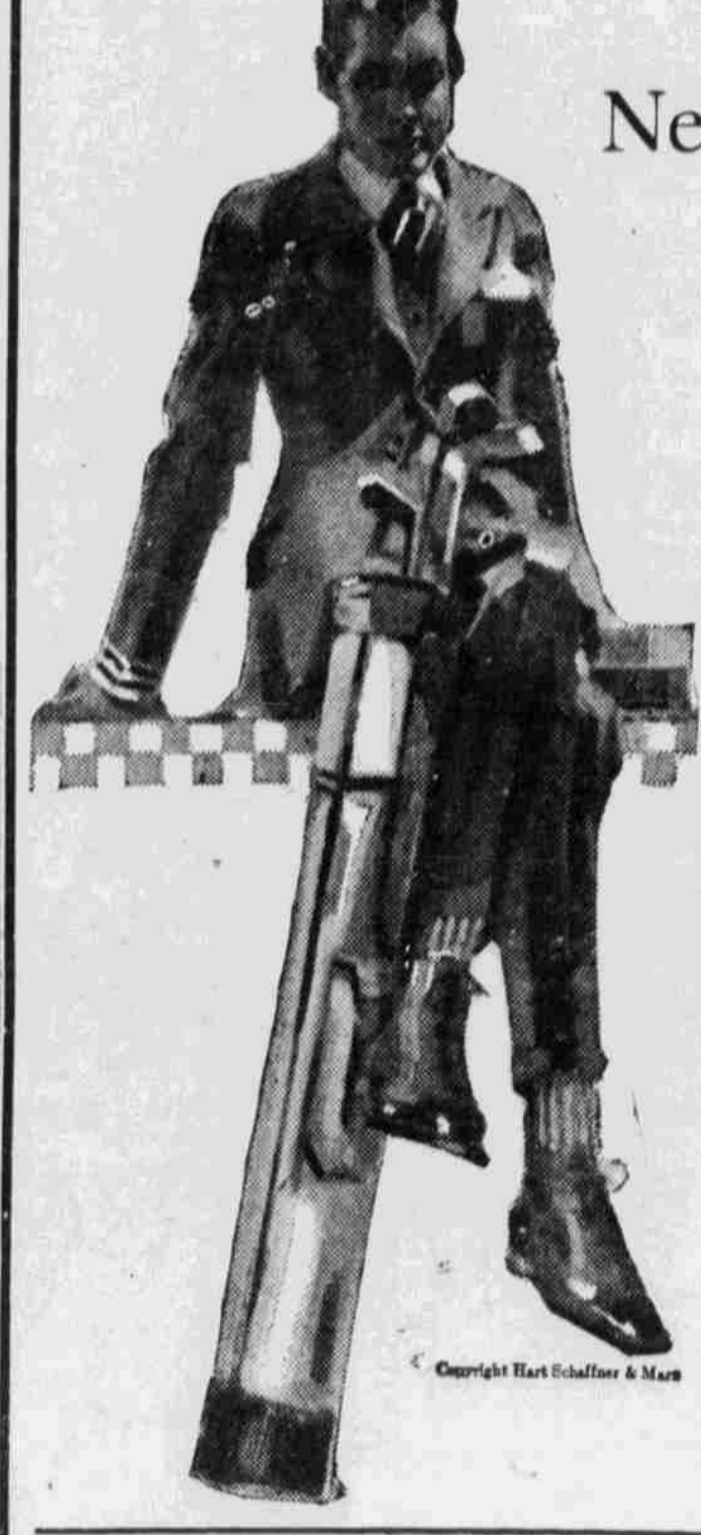
see how varied and adaptable printed matter is and how it can be used to help increase the general business of the great trade center.
