

PICTURES ADDED TO PAPER PRINTED FOR ARMY BOYS

(Correspondence of the Associated Press.) Paris, April 30.—The Bulletin of the Army, a periodical that has been published since early in the war for the benefit of the soldiers at the

front, has been transformed into an illustrated paper, that recalls somewhat the publications of the revolutionary period. The cover of the first illustrated issue was designed by Bernard Naudin, whose work is full of the atmosphere of "Old France." At the top of the front cover is the French

standard crossed over a stack of arms, and at the bottom one of the new army helmets surrounded by laurel leaves. The back cover presents a proud rooster, standing upon trophies of war, a French flag in the background.
