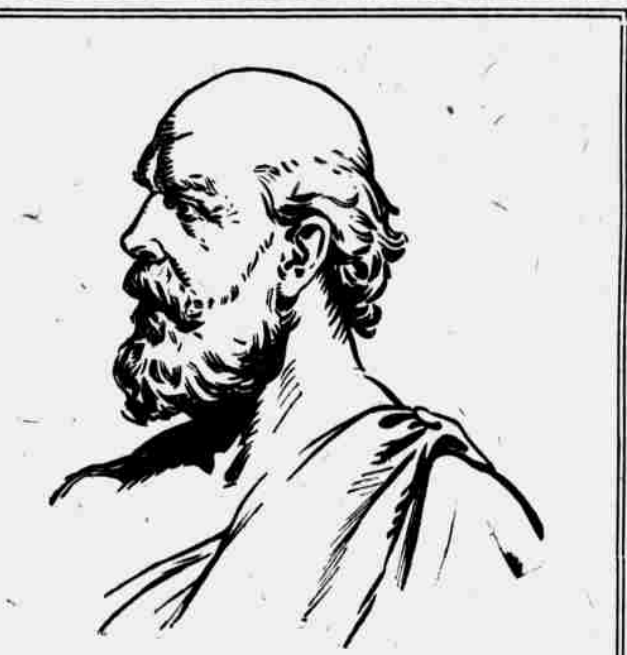

G. B. Ford Tells Council of the Need of the Present and the Future.

"Now is the time for Omaha to begin to work out a comprehensive city plan. This is one of the most popular and valuable projects the city council and City Planning commission could undertake," said George B. Ford of the planning commission, addressing the city council.

"Omaha," he added, "should start without delay to prepare for its great future. It is cheaper and easier to correct mistakes now than it will be in the future. A wise, comprehensive city plan is a prerequisite of a healthy, normal and progressive city."

Makes Stable Values. He explained that a city plan tends toward stability of realty values. Disturbing, zoning, limitation of height of buildings and restrictions of uses of buildings and property were cited as a few of the important problems being worked out by American cities.
