CASH AND PRODUCE

Cash Wheat Breaks Sharply. When Futures Show Heavy Price Declines.

Following the heavy decline in the future market today cash wheat broke sharply and sold from 5 to 10c under yesterday's average price.

The decline today had a demoralizing effect on the cash grain situation and there were very few traders who cared to sell their offerings and as a result a large percentage of the wheat and corn and practically all the oat samples were held over.

The wheat sample of the better grades in the most instances brought about 8c under the market yesterday, the No. 2 hard selling today at \$1.30 and the No. 2 hard going at \$1.27 1/2. Mixed wheat generally brought the hard winter price, but the No. 2 soft sold at a discount, the No. 2 selling at \$1.22.

Considering the drop in wheat, the corn market held steady, but it was in this market that broke from 2 to 2 1/2c, No. 3 white and No. 2 yellow selling around 50c and No. 1 white selling around 52c under these prices.
