GRAIN AND PRODUCE

Demand for Wheat is Slow Because of the Many Rumors Which Are in the Air.

CORN IS IN BETTER DEMAND

Omaha, March 14, 1917.

The local cash demand for wheat was slow today and prices on this article were quoted from 1/2 to 3/4 lower. The better grades of wheat, however, were readily taken at the lower prices. A number of traders expressed the belief that choice light wheat would still bring \$1.45. At best it was a slow trade, and even at that not much was done. The only wheat that came in was direct, nothing of consequence in the market showing up. Bulk of the wheat offerings were in milling form, and there seemed little likelihood that anything would go for shipping, while feeders were entirely lacking.

CHICAGO GRAIN AND PROVISIONS.

Rumors of Rail Strikes and Heavy Rains Send Wheat Prices Downward.

Chicago, Ill., March 14.—Railroad notices of freight refusal an account of the threatened strike smashed the wheat market today after prices had been greatly unsettled by the action of a German submarine in sinking the American food-laden steamer Algonquin. Quotations, which at one time showed an extreme break of 50 cents, closed nervous, 1 1/2 to 2 cents lower, with May 1 1/2 to 1 3/4, and July 1 1/2 to 1 3/4. Other commodities, too, all finished at a loss, corn down 1/4 to 1/2, oats to 1 1/2 to 1 3/4, and provisions 1/2 to 3/4.

It was not until the final hour of the session that the wheat trade suddenly awoke to a realization that the proposed strike would seriously hamper the movement of freight traffic. The market, which for some time previous had been on the decline, plunged headlong down and did not stop until the break in value had carried May delivery as low as 1 1/2, against 1 3/4 at yesterday's close. During the break heavy unloading by holders took place and there was pressure of a most energetic sort from buyers. In the end profit-taking by shorts halted the market about 1 1/2 to 1 3/4.
