Omaha, March 29, 1917. Today's receipts of grain were very good, and while all markets were substantially higher, the trade was rather slow because of the fact that several of the sellers held out for better prices on wheat and corn.

The wheat market was very strong at an advance of 2c to 3c, and while there were a few sales of mixed wheat sold, the bulk of the sales were made up of the No. 2 and No. 3 grades of hard winter.

The oats market was very strong compared with the other market, and this was due to the fact that the bulk of the sales were made up of the No. 1 and No. 2 grades of hard winter.

Cattle receipts were 4,084 head, and sheep receipts were 1,212 head. Hog receipts were 1,000 head.
