

Certificate of Inspection

This certifies that I have inspected the motor vehicle headlight and headlight equipment known as the Cravath Long Distance Type Osgood Lens, submitted to me by the Osgood Lens & Supply Company, and find that the same complies with the provisions of the ordinance of the City of Omaha regarding motor vehicle headlights, passed September 22d, 1914.

"Every motor vehicle---while in use on the public high-ways---shall have exhibited during the period from one hour after sunset to one hour before sunrise one or more lamps showing "white" lights, visible within a reasonable distance, etc.--further it shall be unlawful to use on a vehicle of any kind operated on a public highway of this state any lighting device of over four candle power equipped with a reflector, unless the same shall be so designed, deflected or arranged that no portion of the beam or reflected light when measured 75 feet or more ahead of the lamp shall rise above 42 inches from the level surface on which the vehicle stands under all conditions of load."

Extract from amendment to Sec. 305 Revised Statutes relating to lights on motor vehicles.
