Gather Up the Fragments. "They might easily have said, 'We don't need to gather up the fragments. The Master can make more bread when we are hungry as he made this. But the important thing is that they did gather up the fragments and saved

hem," said Dr. Groh. "Waste is our great national fault today. Through years of prosperity we have come to have a false standard Those who have money seek to make the fact known to their neighbors by showing how much they can waste Honest thrift has come to be looked on as meanness and stinginess.

"When I was a boy, I remember men would work from sun to sun for what they earn in an hour now Women worked at 25 cents a day, and it wasn't an eight-hour day either; i was about a twelve-hour day. O course, in those days you could get a quarter of a carcass of veal for 50 cents and now you pay about that much for two pounds.

Hives of Industry. "In those days the farm houses vere busy hives of industry, too. All brough the winter, the spinning wheels were busy spinning the flax and weaving the cloth that finally was made into clothing for the members of the family.

"Of course, we don't want to go back to the spinning wheel. But we do need to go back to more of the hardy life of industry and thrift. We need to get rid of our false standards of living and adopt standards of sturdy independence.
