GRAIN AND PRODUCE

All of Grain Markets Continue Dull Except Corn, Which Hits New High Levels.

Omaha, July 30, 1917. The local trade in cash grain was confined mainly to the corn market and prices on this cereal advanced to new high levels.

The demand for corn was good and arrivals were very heavy, a total of 281 samples being offered on the tables, but traders did not get together very readily and as a result quite a number of samples were laid over for tomorrow's market.

The wheat market continued dull and featureless and sellers reported only a limited amount for the better grades of hard winter. The tone of the wheat market was steady, with No. 2 hard winter selling at \$2.20 and No. 2 mixed at \$2.10.

Cash corn ruled from 2 1/2 to 2 3/4 above the quotations of Saturday, the white grade selling up to \$2.30, while the yellow ranged from \$2.24 to \$2.24 and the mixed brought \$2.16 to \$
