# TURKEY SUPPLY NOW PLENTIFUL

Millions of Pounds Will Be Thrown on Market Soon to Supply Thanksgiving Day Demand.

Turkeys placed in cold storage in 1916, as much as 1,500,000 pounds of them, will soon be thrown on the market throughout the United States for the Thanksgiving demand.

The United States food administration has had a survey made of the cold storage houses and has learned that there are plenty of turkeys in storage for the Thanksgiving season, administration officials estimating that these soon will be on the market at lower figures.

Under the provisions of the food control act, the administration will force that portion of the turkey suppply stored in 1916 upon the market now. It is desired that this be brought out for consumption instead of being held any longer.

· Chickens Also Released. administration estimates that of the 6,000,000 pounds of turkeys stored in cold storage during the latter part of 1916, 25 to 30 per cent is still in storage. This would be at least 1,500,000 pounds.

A heavy stock of chickens was also found to be in storage, at least 25,-300,000 pounds, which are also to be released for the market now.

The proposed Omaha interstate fair has been abandoned owing to inability to get the support of Ak-Sar-Ben. 


