Cattle—Receipts today amounted to 1,700 head, making 37,000 for the week, as compared with 34,376 head last week and 23,225 head the corresponding week a year ago. Quality of the receipts were just ordinary, including but a few loads of medium to good steers and nothing real choice on sale. Trading was generally on a steady to strong basis and on choice steers 10c to 15c higher for the week and on the medium grades, 25c to 50c higher. Good to choice steers are quotable from \$17.25 and \$17.75, and fair to good steers from \$16.25 to \$17.00 and from that on down to the common and warmed up grades. Butcher stock was generally steady, there being but a few odd assortments in the offerings and trade is generally 1c to 40c higher for the week ranging on cows from \$12.00 to \$14.00 on the good kind and from that on down toward the other. There were very few feeders on sale, prices are steady to easier for the week. Yearlings have shown a slight advance, \$1.00 to \$1.25, and are generally 50c to \$1.00 for the week and quotable from \$14.75 to \$16.50 for the good to choice and from \$11.00 to \$13.75 for the fair to good grades.
