

REDS SPLIT EVEN WITH DODGERS IN DOUBLE BATTLE

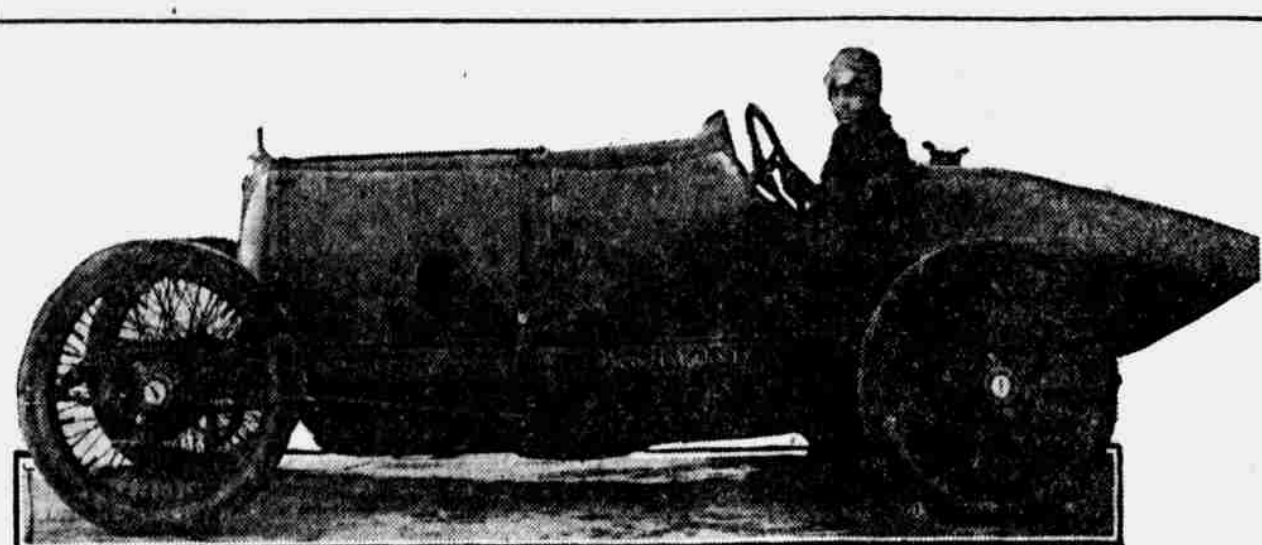
New York and Chicago Divide Two Games, Causey Winning Seventh Straight Contest.
