Alleged I. W. W. on Trial for Assaulting Young Girl

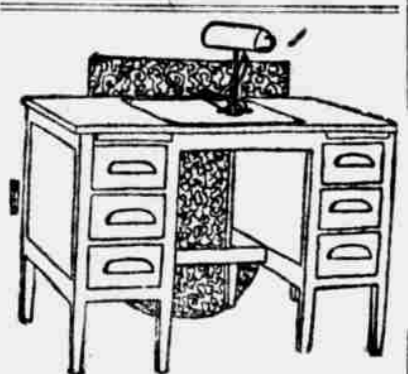
The trial of Frank A. Neary, 28 years old, no address, on the charge of criminally assaulting Lillian Hanson, aged 7 years, on July 11, last, began in Judge Redick's court Tuesday. The girl testified on her own behalf that she was accompanied by little Kenneth Kenersh, near her home at 2112 South Fourth street, at the time, when Neary went the other boy away on an errand and assaulted her. Neary was captured after a man hunt lasting several days. He is said to be a member of the Industrial Workers of the World and to have been caught in the raid of the government officials last fall on the Industrial Workers of the World headquarters.

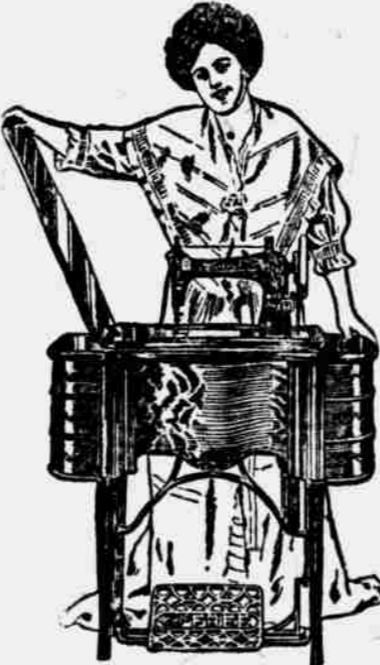
