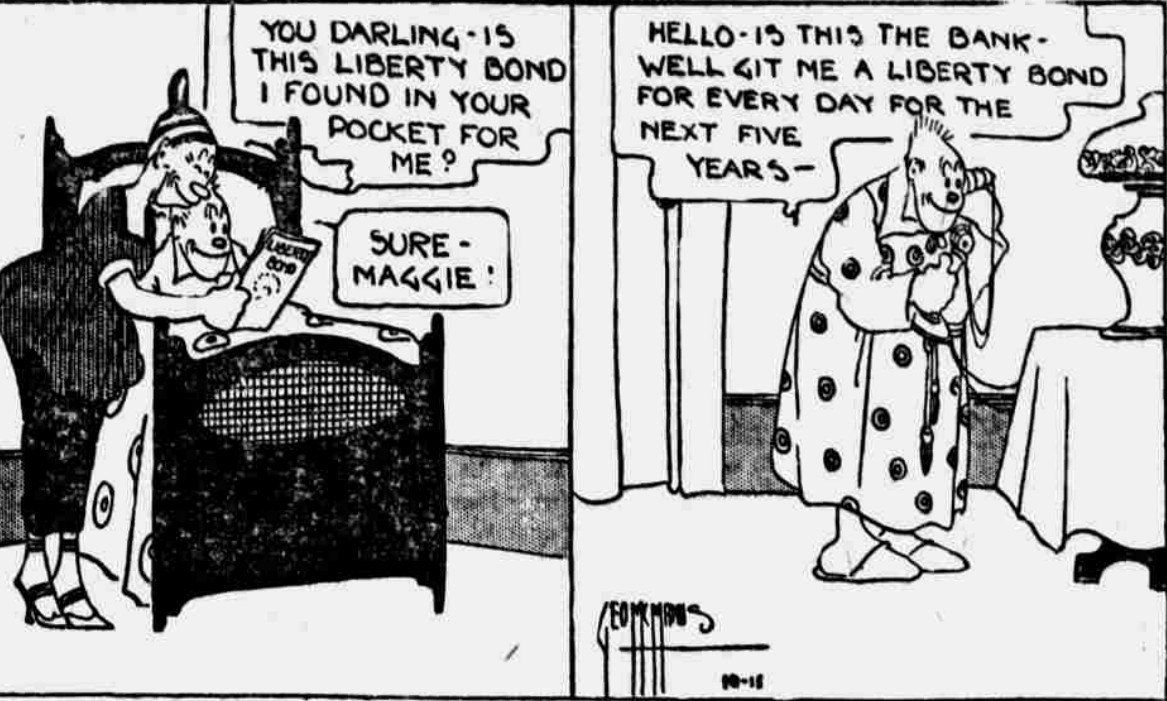

New York, Oct. 14.—A series of intercollegiate foot ball games, to be played for the benefit of the war charities fund, will be the outstanding feature of the sport next month.

The decision to advocate the playing of such games, it became known today, was reached at a recent conference of government and foot ball authorities.

A meeting of the committee will be held in this city soon, when complete plans for the series will be arranged in a general way and subject to such changes as may be necessary.
