PROSECUTION IN AIRCRAFT CASES TO BE PROMPT

Evidence Found by Hughes May Be Laid Before Federal Grand Jury at Washington.

Washington, Nov. 1.—Prosecution of the three army officers held by the aircraft investigation to be guilty of dealing with corporations in which they were financially interested, it was said today at the Department of Justice.

The officers are Lt. Col. J. G. Vincent, former vice president of the Packard Motor car company; Lt. George W. Mixer, a stockholder in the Curtiss airplane and motor corporation and Lt. Samuel B. Vrooman, jr., a stockholder in the S. B. Vrooman company of Philadelphia.

Reports that other army officers commissioned since the nation entered the war have been dealing with firms in which they have a financial interest are being investigated by agents of the Department of Justice.

Secretary Baker said today he had not completed his study of Mr. Hughes' report and was not prepared to announce his action upon recommendation of Mr. Hughes the bureau of military aeronautics, be brought to court-martial for the alleged supplying of confidential War department information to former business assistants in Dayton, Ohio.

Request for any inquiry by the War department into aircraft affairs was made some months ago by Maj. Gen. George O. Squier, Col. Deeds and other officials, but Secretary Baker held it in abeyance until the investigation of Mr. Hughes and the senate committee has been completed.

Representative Fess of Ohio, chairman of the republican congressional committee, issued a statement today commenting upon the Hughes report and was granted every further investigation into conditions in the spruce producing section of the northwest, as recommended by Mr. Hughes, is to be undertaken by government agents, it was said today.

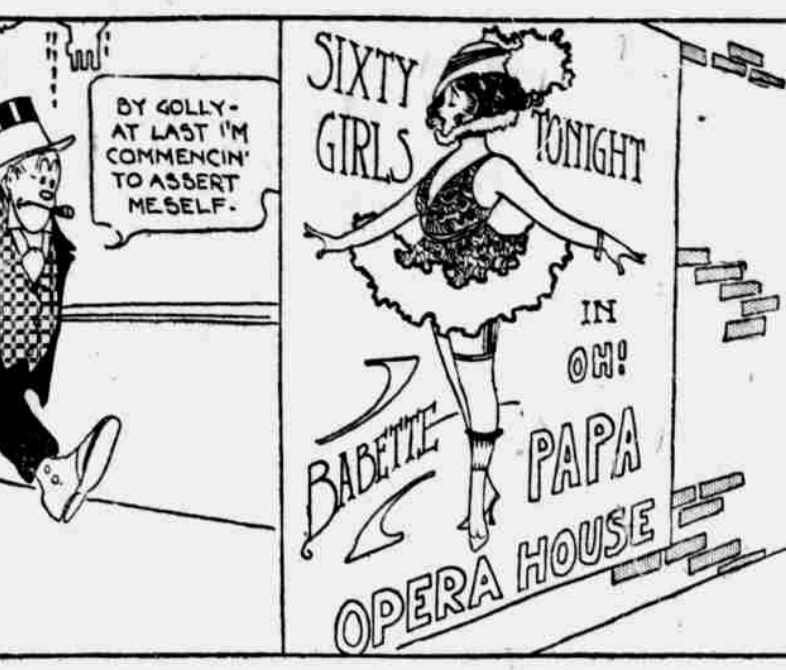
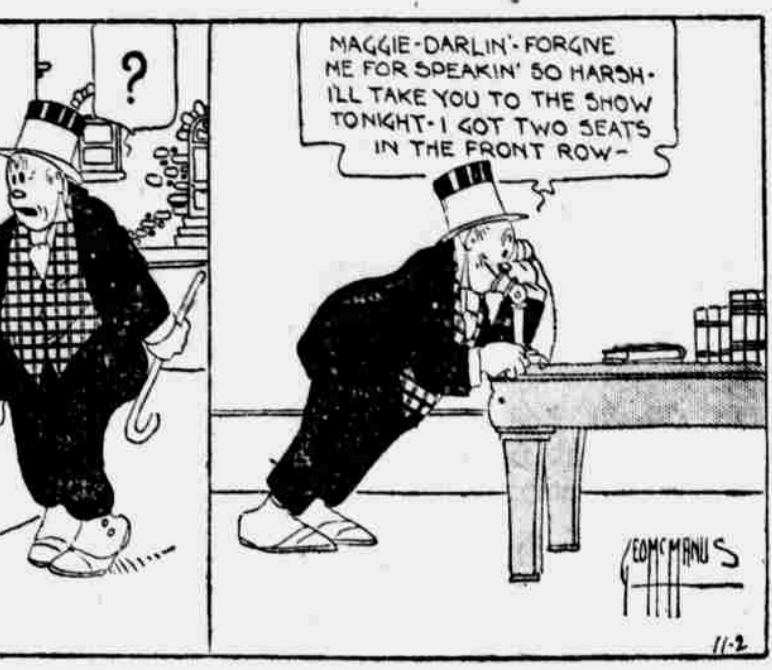
Unconditional Surrender Club is Oklahoma Project

Twenty-three I. W. W. To Appear in Federal Court This Morning

The 23 I. W. W. taken in a raid on their headquarters nearly a year ago, and since held as federal prisoners in the county jail, charged with violation of the espionage act, will appear before Judge Woodrough in federal court Saturday morning.

Assistant United States Attorney Saxton said that while their appearance was not exactly in the form of an arraignment, if any of the prisoners wished to enter pleas they might do so.

The object of their appearance Saturday is to make arrangements for attorneys to represent the defendants in their trial which comes up in the term of court starting November 6.

Several of the prisoners have expressed a desire to act as their own attorneys, but it is not the intention of the authorities that they shall do so.

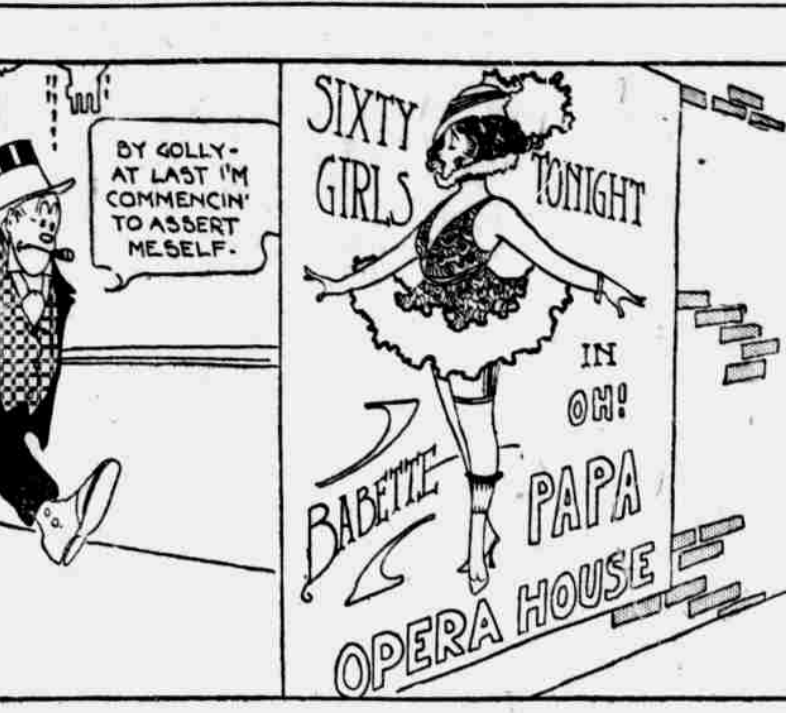

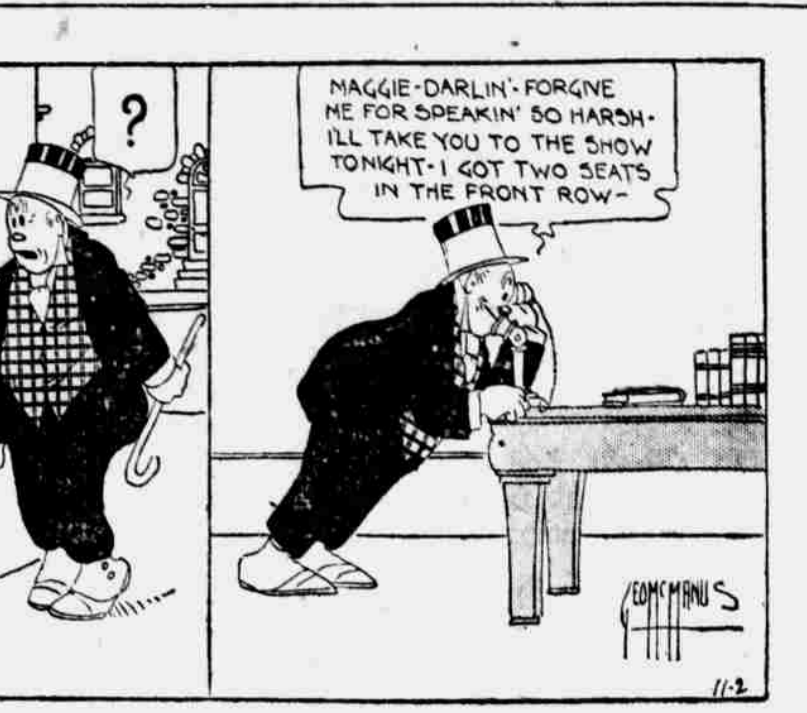

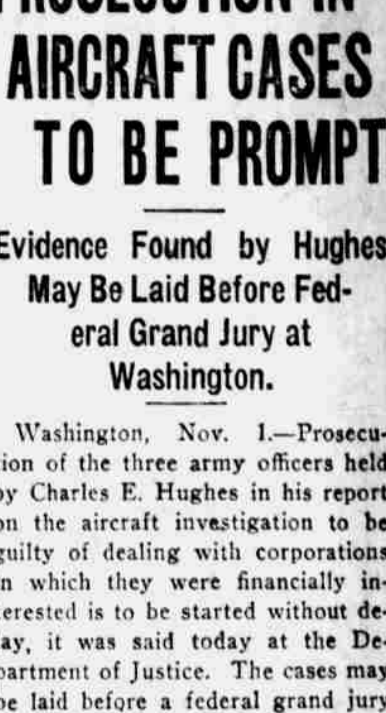
