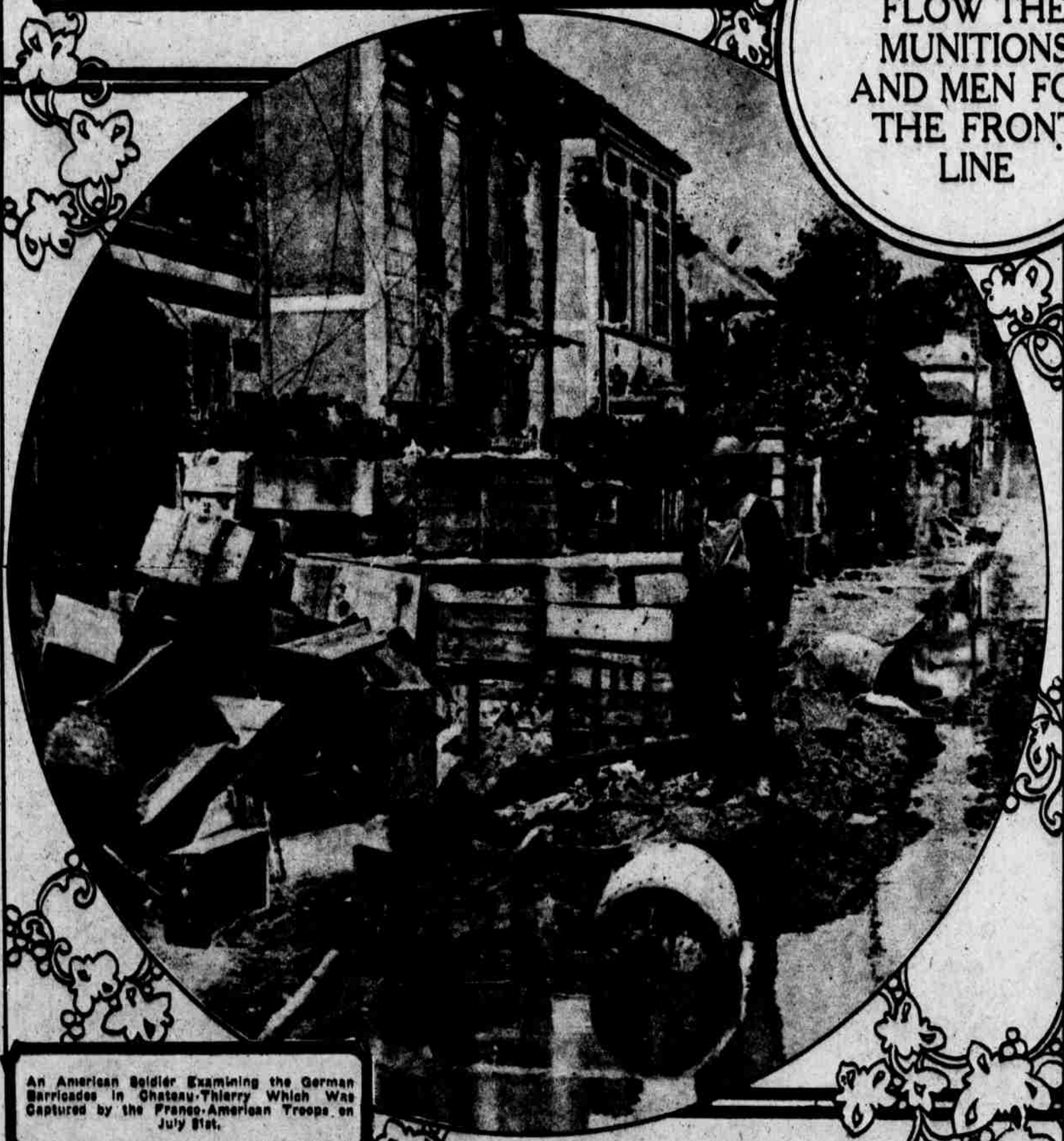


A Great Canadian Ammunition Column Passing a Long Train of the Big Naval Guns on Their Way to the Firing Line.

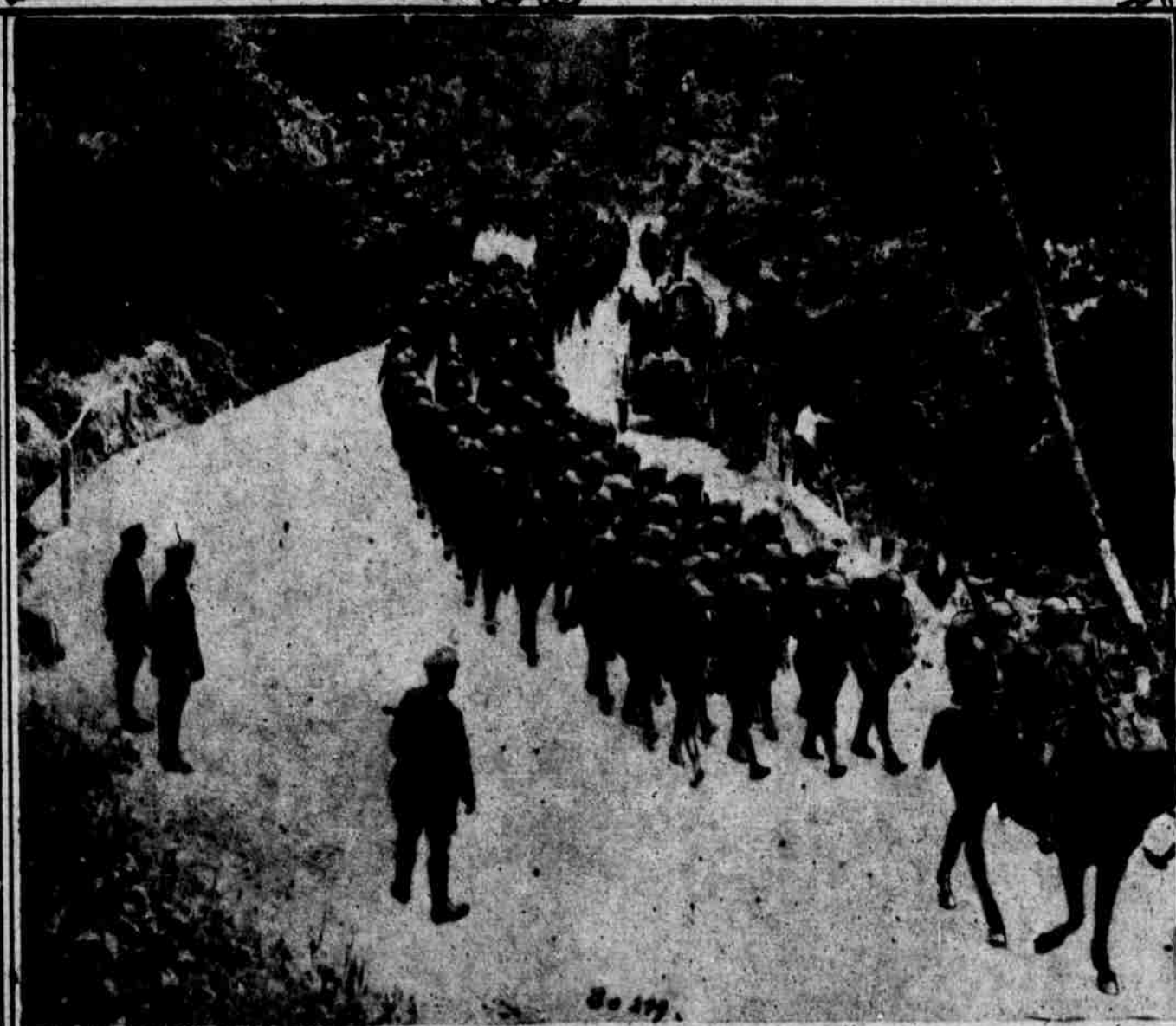

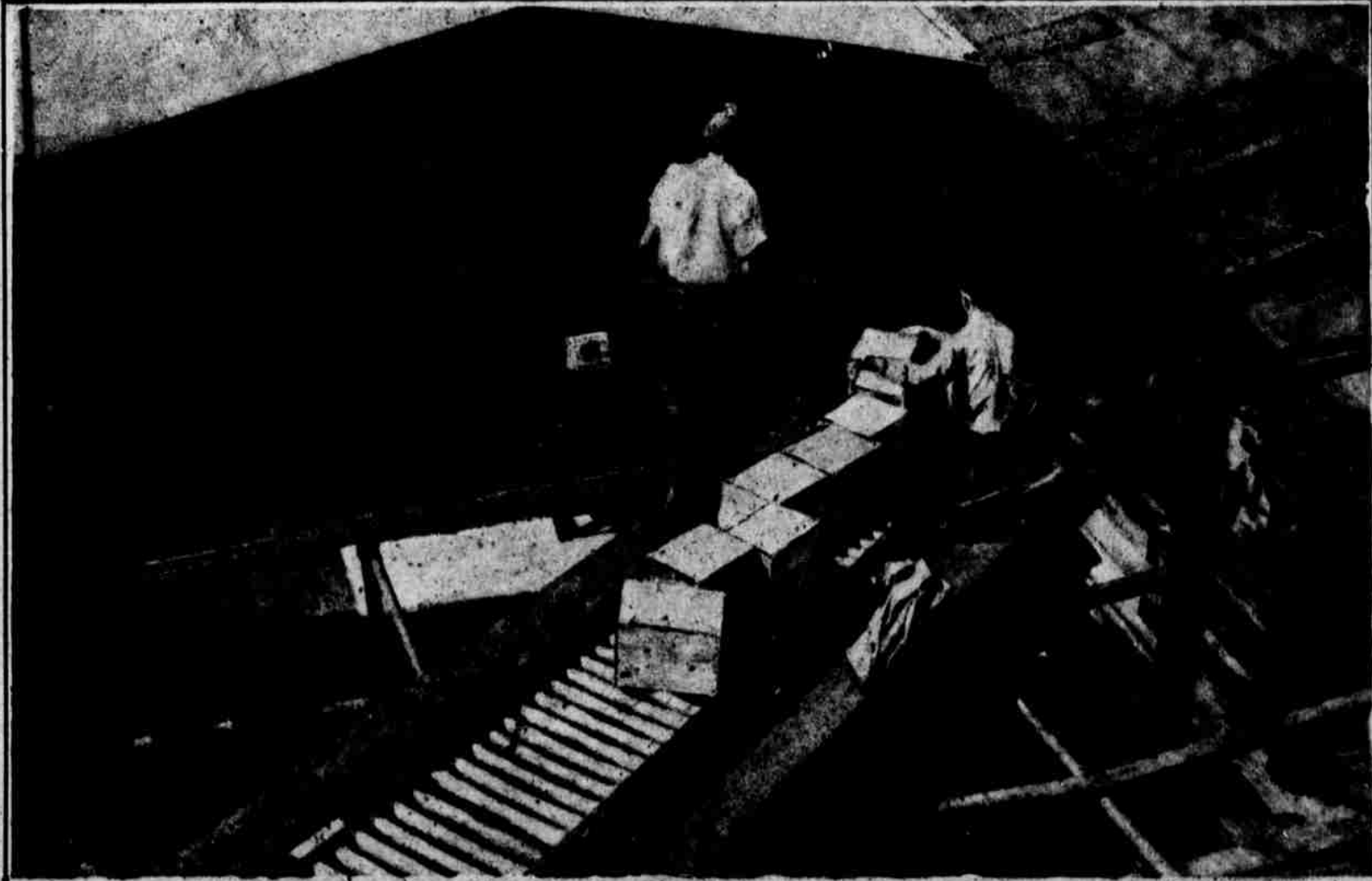
An American Soldier Examining the German Barricades in Chateau-Thierry Which Was Captured by the Franco-American Troops on July 21st.
