A legislative council of women to further the education and prepare women for the franchise will be formed in Lincoln the latter part of this month.

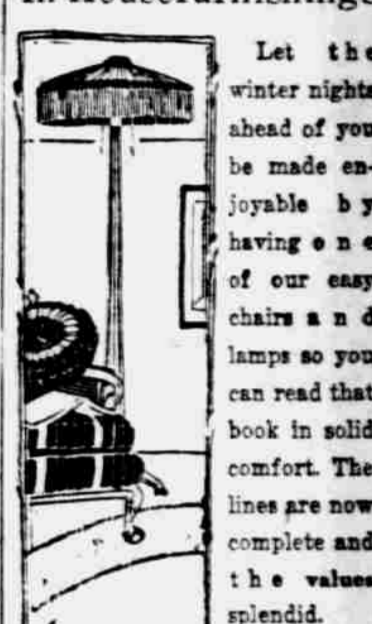
The movement is instituted outside of regular suffrage ranks. At the state convention of the General Federation of Women's clubs to be held late this month in Lincoln...
