Deposits Drop \$13,000,000 in  
Two Months, Attributed by  
Bankers to Liberty Loan  
Subscriptions.

Omaha bank loans made an increase in the last two months, according to the report made Friday in response to a call from the national comptroller of the currency for the condition of the banks November 1. The gain amounted to nearly \$3,000,000.

Deposits in the banks showed a decrease, the amount reported on August 31 for deposits was \$114,081,759, and for November 1 \$104,742,547.

John P. Cummins, inspector of United Pacific passenger stations and passenger service and equipment is back from a trip that took him as far west as San Francisco. He reports business very good. "Everywhere in the west Mr. Cummins came in contact with the influenza, but happened to be immune. In San Francisco and the other cities he found a ban existing against holding public meetings and the assembling of crowds. On the streets, on trains and in the transaction of business, people, both men and women, wore masks. In San Francisco there was a police order in effect, requiring the wearing of masks. Its violation meant a fine or jail sentence."
