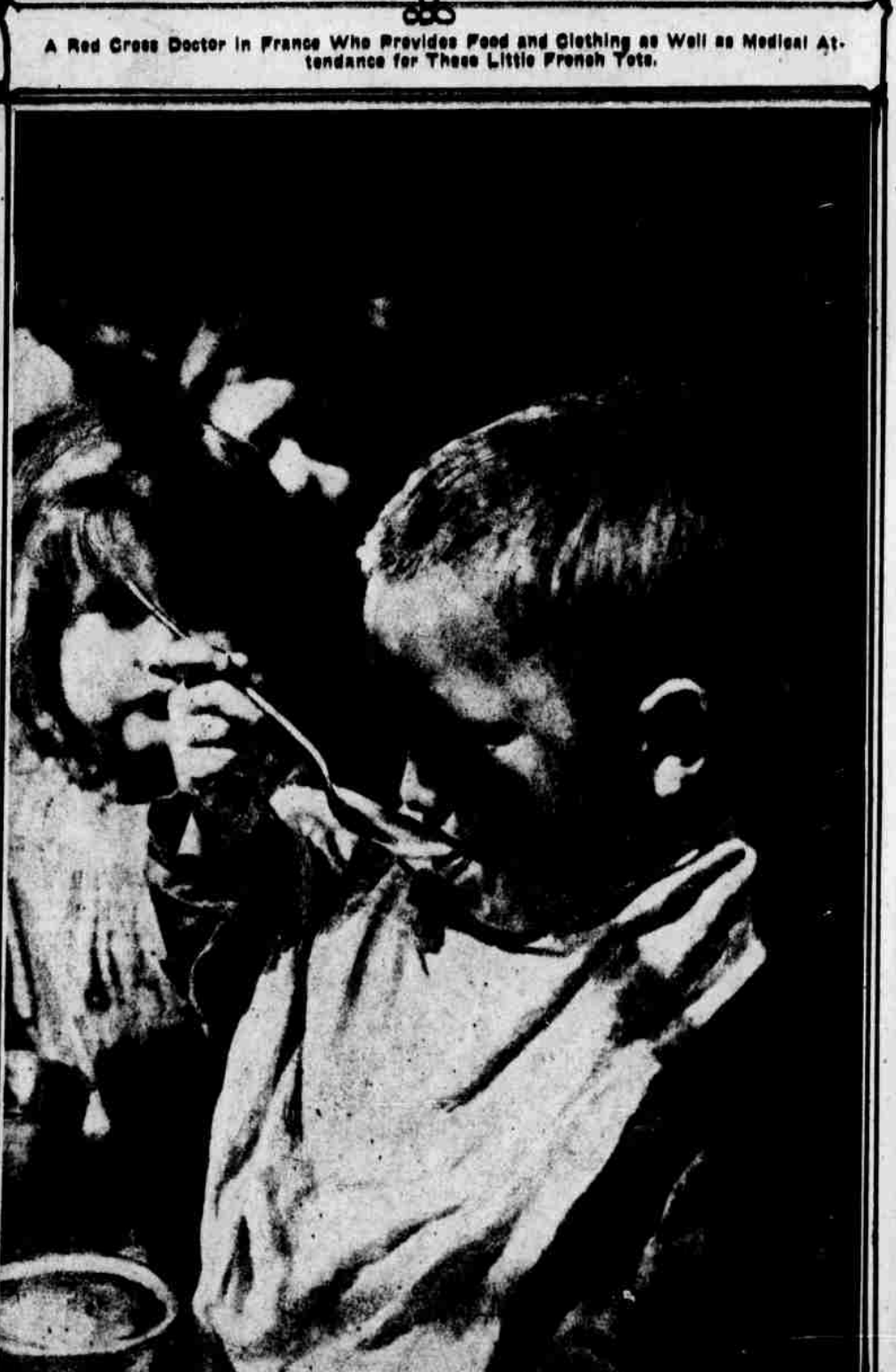
A Red Cross Doctor in France Who Provides Food and Clothing as Well as Medical Attendance for These Little French Tots.
