

PLAN REVIVAL OF ATHLETICS COMING YEAR

Sports to Be Re-established on Broader Scale Than Ever Before; Base Ball Leagues to Resume.

New York, Nov. 18.—Sport governing bodies, both amateur and professional, are preparing for revival of competition the coming year.

Major and minor base ball leagues will resume next spring. It is not likely that the game will immediately reach the heights to which it had climbed when the world war first took toll of America's most popular sport.

In track and field athletics it is believed the meets will be held next May and June as usual.

Base ball and rowing, two other major sports at the college during the spring, will also be revived.

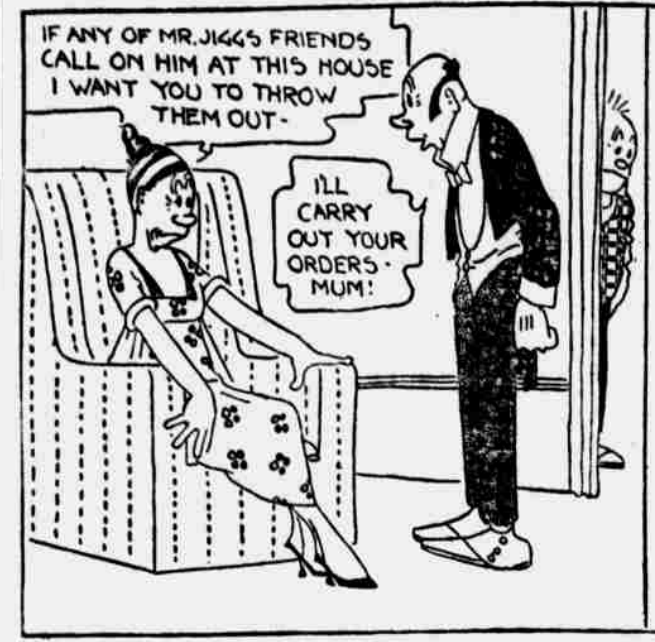

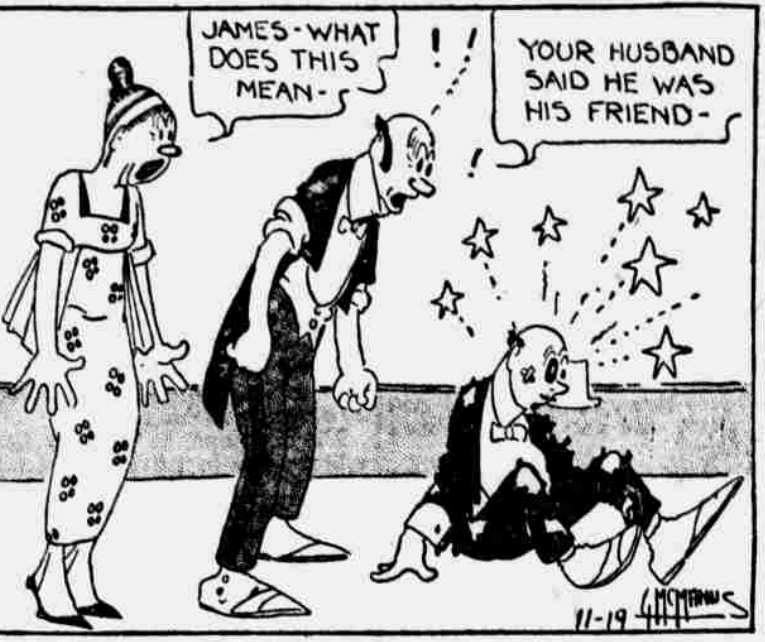
