Minneapolis, Dec. 20.-The price of bran jumped from \$27.73 to \$46 a ton here today, the sudden rise being due to the removal of all milling restrictions by the government.

Victor Parrish of the food administrator's office says the orders here mentioned will make little change in the situation as flour restrictions have been practically removed for more than a month. Strict measures against profiteering will be taken, however,


