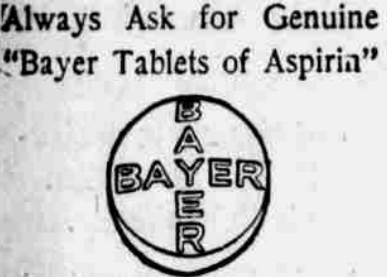

PETITION CITES OPPOSITION TO SCHOOL BILL

State Senate Peruses Arguments Against Harris Amendment to House Roll No. 64.

From a Staff Correspondent. Lincoln, March 24.—In order to bolster up sentiment against the Harris amendment to House Roll No. 64, the education bill, Senator Reed and Representative J. Reid Green, were instrumental in having the office of the chief clerk of the house of representatives today strike off 500 copies of a petition heading, which was to have been circulated all over the state and returned to members of the house and senate with signatures of petitioners prejudiced against the educational measure, as proposed by the senate. The petition heading is as follows: "The officers and members of the Nebraska state senate and the Nebraska house of representatives:

Farmers Oppose Filley Substitute for Anti-Bank Bill

From a Staff Correspondent. Lincoln, March 24.—(Special.)—Further consideration of the anti-bank promotion bill, S. F. No. 244, has been postponed until Wednesday. The intervening time will be used in an effort by the bankers and farmers to get together on some amendments. The Filley substitute for S. F. No. 244 is determinedly opposed by the rural members. It provides that a new bank shall not come under the guaranty law for the first three years of its existence. This is strongly regarded by the farmers as a restriction which would militate very strongly against the success of co-operative banks.

STATE SENATE READY TO PASS CIVIL CODE BILL

Solons Approve Amendments and Send it to Third Reading; Hoagland Seeks to Restrict Finance Dept.

Lincoln, March 24.—The Nebraska senate Monday afternoon voted its approval of the civil administrative code bill, 507 pages long, and sent it to third reading after a few minor amendments had been accepted. The bill will be up for final passage tomorrow and will then go to the house. Senator Reed succeeded in tacking on one amendment which places the food, drug, dairy, weights and measures work under the jurisdiction of the department of agriculture instead of the department of public welfare. Senator Hoagland sent up a series of amendments seeking to restrict the authority of the department of finance; one repealed a section of the bill, conferring on the department the right to require any corporation or individual to report its standing at any time. Hoagland contended the section conferred undue powers in the governors and secretaries of the department. Hoagland succeeded in getting a provision stricken out which gave the finance department authority to raise or lower the assessment fixed by the state board of equalization.

House Committee Reports on Dairy Products' Bills

Lincoln, March 24.—(Special.)—Three of the bills amending and amplifying the state laws pertaining to milk, cream and the dairy and cheese industries and the manufacture and sale of imitation butter products were considered by the house committee of the whole Monday forenoon and advanced to third reading. They are: H. R. No. 461—To regulate the testing of milk and cream; H. R. No. 474—Fixing standards of milk and cream; requiring everyone who sells milk from more than three cows to take out a state license at \$1 per year, unless sold direct to a cheese factory or creamery; requiring milk to be sold in bottles and reducing the license for imitation cheese and butter to \$1.

Returned Soldiers Praise Employment Bureau of the C. of C.

Spring calls for farm jobs are now being filled by the Chamber of Commerce employment bureau for soldiers and sailors. F. M. Harrison of Hamilton, S. D., arrived in Omaha yesterday morning for help. Eight former soldiers were supplied in a jiffy by Mrs. Mabel Walker, in charge of the bureau. Harrison and his recruits left for the farm shortly afterward. Everybody happy. George Runyan, placed on a farm through the Chamber of Commerce bureau, wrote Mrs. Walker that his employer was paying him \$75 per month, instead of the \$60 at which pay he had been hired. Runyan was lavish in his praise of the bureau which has placed 1,304 soldiers in employment.

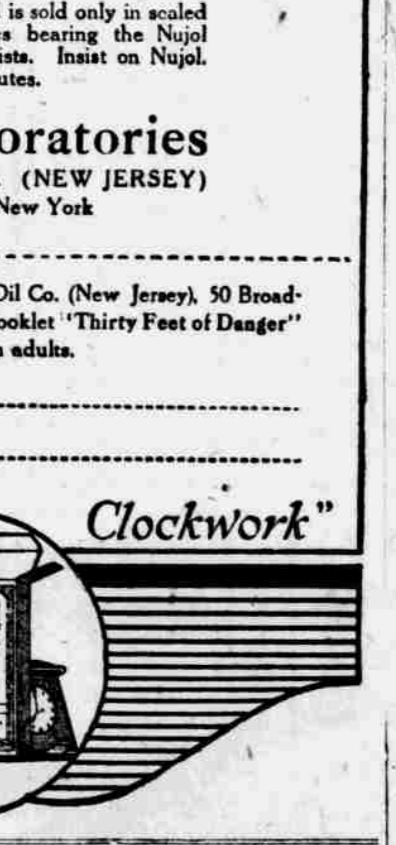

Kansas Sees Help in Action vs. Telephone Rates Lincoln, March 24.—(Special.)—Kansas will appreciate any co-operation Nebraska can give in the original action brought by the Kansas railway commission contesting the Burleson telephone rates in the United States supreme court, according to a letter from S. F. Jackson, attorney for the Kansas commission, to Clarence A. Davis, attorney general for Nebraska. Mr. Davis had written the Kansas officials, volunteering the co-operation of Nebraska and offering to join with Kansas in its suit. Mr. Jackson's suggestion that Nebraska join the action as a friend of the court, or co-operate in any other way the court would permit will be accepted.

- Bills Passed (House.) Lincoln, March 24.—The constitutional convention bill, S. F. No. 217, was among a dozen others which Governor R. R. McKelvie signed this morning. The list follows: H. R. No. 246—County superintendent's salaries bill. H. R. No. 106—School teachers required to attend normal school. H. R. No. 235—Vocational education appropriation of \$100,000. H. R. No. 235—Deficiency appropriation of \$288,000 for state institutions. H. R. No. 204—Raising pay of road over-seer. S. F. No. —Examination of school children by teachers or physicians for defective sight or hearing, diseased teeth and nasal obstructions. S. F. No. 129 and 131—Omaha water district to construct electric plant when constructed or acquired and limit taken off R. B. Howell's salary as general manager. S. F. No. 86—Auto and tractor supplies and parts to be kept on sale where the machines are sold. S. F. No. 254—Requesting Perahing to send back the soldiers. S. F. No. —Requesting boards in cities of 1,500 population and upward empowered to issue bonds or warrants for payment of special indebtedness upon 51 per cent. interest.

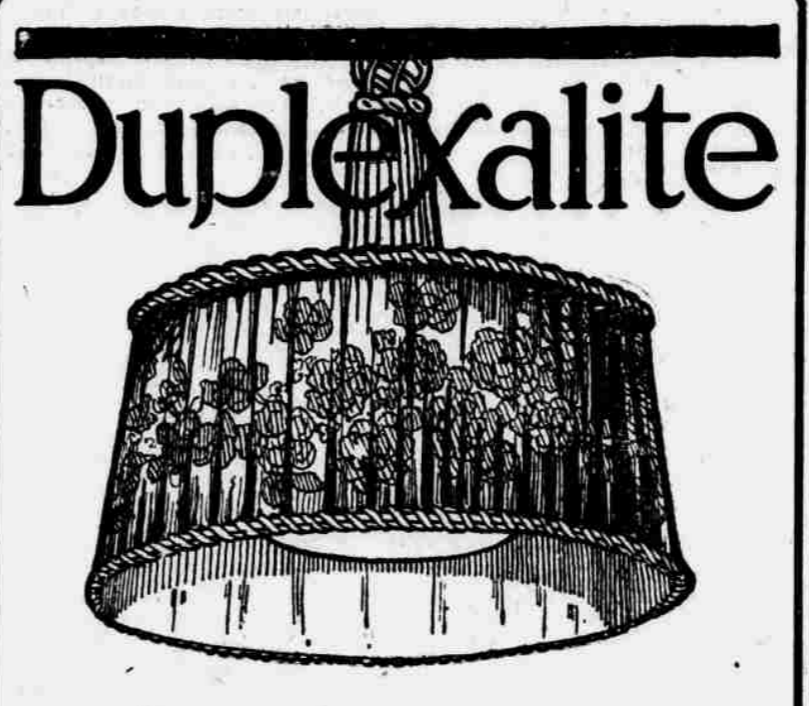
