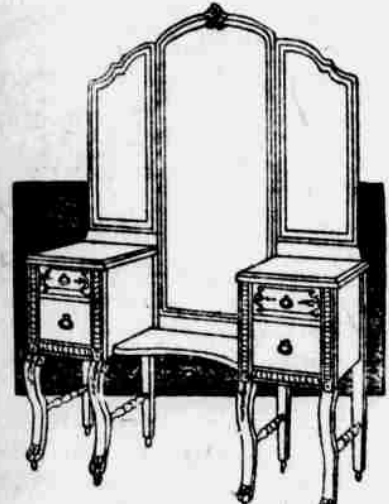

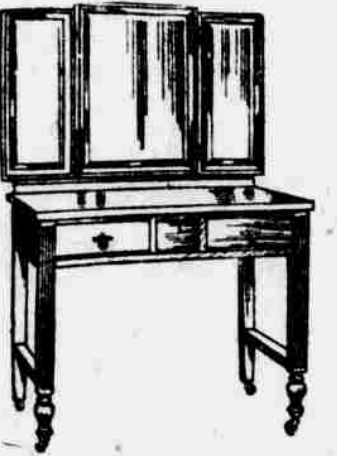

Sunday Dinners Will Be Very Costly

Fresh Vegetables and Luscious Strawberries on the Market for Those Who Can Pay the Price.

Springy, tasty, but also alas, very high will be the Sunday dinner of Midday the Hostess for this week.

Butter has had its ups and downs—decidedly in the last seven days. Friday, the price fell to 57 cents.

Eggs, too, are high—40 and 45 cents, although cheese is but 38 cents. Seek recipes of cheese, Mrs. Housewife.

Strawberries, too—luscious, red, but small of box are on the market for 25 cents a pint.

Rhubarb, too, is fresh this week—California rhubarb at 12 1/2 cents the pound; cauliflower, 12 1/2 cents; tomatoes, 20 cents a pound and cucumbers, 30 cents each.

Vegetables, now common on the market, retain their same prices: radishes and shallots, 7 cents the bunch; onion sets, four squarts for 25 cents, and seed potatoes, \$1.60 per bushel.

Canned goods vary decidedly—the canned fruits are higher and have prospects of still being higher.

Apricot Roll. Two cups of flour, two tablespoons sugar, four teaspoons baking powder, half teaspoonful salt, two tablespoons solid vegetable fat, but two-thirds cup milk or water; mix and sift the dry ingredients, cut in the shortening, add the liquid gradually, using a knife to mix; roll out on a floured board until one-fourth inch thick; spread with the fruit, which has been cooked and sweetened but the juice drained off; sprinkle a few nuts over the top of the fruit, then roll the dough into a long roll as for cinnamon rolls. Cut into one and one-half inch slices and place, cut side down, in oiled muffin pans. Bake in a hot oven for 20 minutes. Serve hot with the above fruit sauce.
