F. X. Lemieux, Pioneer Business Man, Dies; Lived Here 42 Years

Frank X. Lemieux, 70 years old, business man and for 42 years a resident of Omaha, died Friday afternoon following a lingering illness at his residence, 408 William street.

Mr. Lemieux was born in Quebec, Canada, in 1849, and when 18 years old took up his home in Cleveland, O., where he attended high school and later was graduated from a business college in Philadelphia. He made his home in the Pennsylvania city, and then moved to Omaha, where for 15 years he was employed in the auditor's office of the Burlington railroad.

Mr. Lemieux resigned his position with the railroad company 25 years ago to enter the fire insurance brokerage business, and for years was connected with the Webster-Howard & Co. in the Bee building.

Mr. Lemieux was married to Miss Margaret C. Holden, of Iowa City, Ia., November 28, 1883.

Funeral services will be conducted at 9 o'clock Monday morning at the residence and St. Philomena church, Tenth and William streets. Burial will be in Holy Sepulchre cemetery.

Mrs. Lemieux is the only surviving member of the family.
