Limerick Trades and Labor Council May Issue Own Money

Limerick, Ireland, April 22.—(By The Associated Press.)—The general strike here incident to the proclamation of Limerick as a military area, assumed a new and interesting phase today when the finance commission of the Limerick trades and labor council announced that it was preparing to issue its own money in the form of a shilling and 10 shilling notes which would be used in the purchase of food for the 14,000 strikers.

The notes are printed in different colors to show their denomination. They are inscribed as follows: "General strike against British militarism, April 1919. The Limerick trades and labor council promise to pay bearer 10 shillings."
