-Both men are known as desperate characters and are heavily armed. They are also wanted in Pueblo, Colo., for the murder of William T. tee which was appointed by the city Hunter and A. C. Parks, committed on the Rye road on the night of April 11, two days before they are alleged to have perpetrated the hold-

Gillmore's two assailants correspond to the identity of the murder-ers of Hunter and Parks near Pueblo, according to Sheriff W. E. Condit of Fremont.

Declares Enlisted Men Do Not Receive Same Consideration of Rights as Officers Enjoy.

Washington, April 22. Lieutenant Colonel Ansell, former acting judge advocate general, continued today his attack upon the army system of justice before the investigating committee of the American Bar association. Declaring it a fact that the elisted man did not receive the same consideration of his rights under the system that officers enjoyed, Colonel Ansell argued that the only remedy lay in writing into the law the guarantees of the rights of the soldier. While this is left to regulations to be prescribed by the president, he said, it cannot be effective The attitude of the army," he added, "has been intolerant toward those methods necessary to justice, They do not take kindly to legal restraints." While a commander of troops must necessarily have arbitrary
