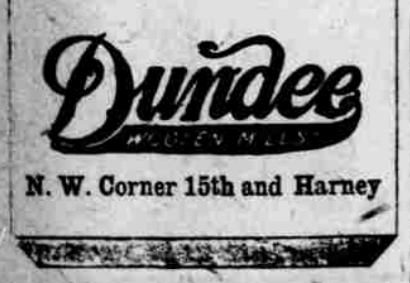

RULER AT OMSK SETS FORTH AIMS OF HIS REGIME

Admiral Kolchak in Message to America Urges Support of 'All-Russian Government.'

Omsk, Siberia, April 1.—(Via San Francisco, April 25.)—(By Courier to the Associated Press.)—Admiral Kolchak, supreme ruler of the All-Russian government, sends a message to America, urging support of the Omsk regime, in a statement to the Associated Press, giving in detail his ideals for Russia and the Russians.

He declared that the government's aims were to free the people from the "Bolshevik lash," "save the last remains of the national wealth," and reconstruct the country politically, economically and morally.
