

NO INQUEST OVER FOUR CHILDREN DROWNED IN LAKE

County Attorney Shotwell Expresses Opinion Official Does Not Warrant Evidence Probe of Tragedy.

It is unlikely that there will be an inquest into the death of the four St. Agnes parish pupils drowned in Riverview park Thursday afternoon when attending a picnic held by pupils of St. Agnes convent music class.

"I have been unable to place any criminal responsibility for the tragedy," A. V. Shotwell, county attorney, said yesterday morning. "There may have been some negligence, and there doubtless was, but there has not yet been presented to me facts that would warrant an official probe into circumstances leading up to the tragedy. However, Paul Steinhilber is looking into the matter now, and until I get his last report I shall not definitely decide what to do."

The four who lost their lives were Josephine Fritz, 13, 2512 Q street; Theresa Duffy, 14, 4622 South Twenty-third street; Anna Grabusch Krissman, 14, 5428 South Twenty-third street, and Edward Schneider, 10, 2717 South Twenty-third street. There were 12 rescued. The accident occurred in 10 feet of water, the center and deepest part of the small lake at Riverview park.

Gloom Over St. Agnes.

A pall of gloom descended on St. Agnes parish "real" mother of the word of the quadruple tragedy came to South Side. Mothers of children at the picnic in Riverview were frantic until assured their offspring were safe. Yesterday morning this gloom was not dispelled. It dampened the ardor for the holiday and many who had planned coming into Omaha to witness the parades remained at home.

Mrs. Duffy, mother of Josephine, one of those drowned, became hysterical at Riverview park, where she had hurried immediately after receiving word her daughter had lost her life. Little Joe Schneider endeavored to jump into the lake when his brother's body was brought ashore. Strong hands held him back and he was finally put into an automobile and taken home by friends of the family.

It is likely that burial of the four will be made Monday when a public funeral will be held.

Socialists Suspend 25,000 Extremists; Call Chicago Meet

Chicago, May 30.—Ten members of the national executive committee of the socialist party are in session here, and today it was announced that 25,000 of the extremist wing of the party had been suspended by vote of the committee. Further announcements were that the committee had decided to call the national convention for Chicago on August 30 and to start nation-wide meetings on July 4 to demand Eugene V. Debs' release from prison and to issue statements giving socialist views on the peace conference and other subjects.

According to Adolph Germer, the party's secretary, who asked ejection of the expelled members, the ousted units are members of the Russian, Lithuanian, Ukrainian, Lettish, Polish, South Slav and Hungarian branches, who "made no pretense of obeying the party platform."

May Start Aerial Line Between U. S. and Canada

St. Johns, N. F., May 30.—Newfoundland soon may be connected with the United States and Canada by aerial mail and passenger lines, it developed today, when the lower house of the colonial legislature ratified a concession granted the Imperial Aircraft Manufacturing company of London.

According to a representative of the company, service will be first introduced between St. Johns and Montreal.

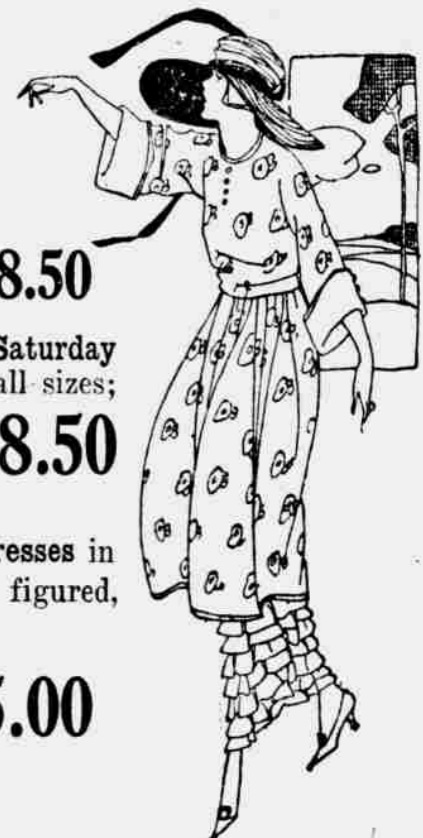
