Unusual Salad Dressings

While there are not many kinds of salad dressings from the standpoint of main ingredients, there are innumerable variations to give a new tang to an old salad. The main kinds are just three—mayonnaise, French dressing and cooked salad dressing. The variations in the mayonnaise and French dressing come from adding highly flavored ingredients like green peppers and pimientos or cheese; the cooked dressings are legion, though all are really highly seasoned vinegar or lemon juice combinations.

Thousand Island Dressing

1 1/2 c. mayonnaise or 2 T. club sauce
1/2 c. chopped green peppers
1/2 c. chopped pimiento
1/2 c. chopped onion
1/2 c. chopped radishes, etc.
2 T. chopped onion.

Mix all ingredients and serve on lettuce. Some of the flavoring ingredients may be omitted.

Hispanian Fruit Salad Dressing.

Juice of 1 lemon
1/2 c. oil
2 c. fruit
White of 1 egg
1 T. sugar

Buttermilk Dressing

1/2 c. butter
1/2 c. cornstarch
1/2 c. mustard
1/2 c. paprika
1 T. salt

Mix ingredients and serve on head lettuce.

Question Box

Is it possible to use anything but olive oil for French dressing and mayonnaise? I have always used olive oil, but find its cost nearly prohibitive now.—Mrs. L. J. W.

While no substitute oil gives the flavor of olive oil, cottonseed oil (sold as "salad oil" usually), corn oil or peanut oil, may be used with the olive oil (half and half) so that the characteristic olive taste is retained. However, any of the substitute oils are very palatable alone and much cheaper.
