SUGAR SHORTAGE.

PITS AN END TO CANNING SEASON. Few Changes in Omaha Market Prices This Week—First California Apples Arrive.

The shortage of sugar is putting a stop to the canning season and unless a sufficient amount is soon received large quantities of peaches and pears will be wasted, according to local growers.

There are no particular changes in local market prices this week. The first fancy eating apples from California have arrived and are selling for 40 cents a small basket.

United States Steel registered a gross Federal of 3 points, but displayed some support in the final dealings of the day, also including the better known shares, making moderate improvement.

Oil almost alone ended with variable prices, market steers coming 2 1/2 cents higher, while other grades were unchanged on call.

Malaga and Tokay, California grapes, are on the market for 12 1/2 cents a pound. Forty cents a basket is charged for yellow tomatoes. Honeydew melons are selling for 40 cents. Idaho potatoes are on the local market for 4 and 4 1/2 cents a pound.

Pork chops are still selling for 40 cents a pound and lamb chops at 25 and 35 cents. Sirloin steak is selling between 32 and 35 cents a pound and ground steak at 30 cents.
