

"Demobilized" Eiffel Tower Stormed by Yanks for View of Paris

Paris, Sept. 17.—The Eiffel tower has been "demobilized" and has

again become one of the most popular places of amusement in Paris. During the opening of its return to the public the giant tower was stormed by American officers and doughboys anxious to make the giddy elevator climb to the top, from which a magnificent panoramic view of Paris and its suburbs

for miles around can be obtained. When the War Department took over the Eiffel tower at the beginning of August, 1914, witty Frenchmen gave it the name of the "tailor's conscript in France." Since then it has been used without intermission as the military wireless station of France, and although
