A Good Health Cupboard.

Just as the wise nation "in time of peace prepares for war," so in time of health does the wise housekeeper prepare for illness, or at least makes herself prepared to meet such emergencies as cuts, burns, sprains, bruises and toothache, not to speak of minor ailments such as headaches, indigestion and colds.

The well stocked cupboard, or medicine chest, for ordinary comfort, as well as emergency preparedness should contain a supply of the following: Vaseline, peroxide or any other antiseptic, bicarbonate of soda (common baking soda), court plaster, surgical tape, a roll of gauze bandages, absorbent cotton and a supply of clean, old soft linen cloths.

A hot water bottle and a fountain syringe should always be kept in good working order. Any little leaks can be mended at repair shops for a trifling sum and a hot water bottle is a veritable cure-all for such pains as toothache, carache, or neuralgia.

Clean cloths wrung in hot water and applied steaming are among the best remedies for abdominal pains or to prevent swelling and discoloration of bruises.

A little common salt kept in a glass jar with a tightly screwed top to keep moisture out is useful to make a salt solution for either a tooth or eye wash.

Boric acid, which comes in the form of a white powder, is a good inexpensive remedy to have on hand for canker.

A few simple remedies for sunburn can be had from a drug store. Home made or a favorite brand of cold cream will relieve or prevent many uncomfortable or unsightly skin troubles due to weather exposure.

Common baking soda will come in handy for mosquito and other insect bites, as well as antiseptic wash dissolved in water for any skin trouble.
