

Cattle And Sheep Wanted In Uruguay; Wine Bottles By a Portuguese Concern

This government office has been established in St. Louis to assist firms in the Mississippi valley to obtain their shares of export trade, and it welcomes inquiries from interested parties.

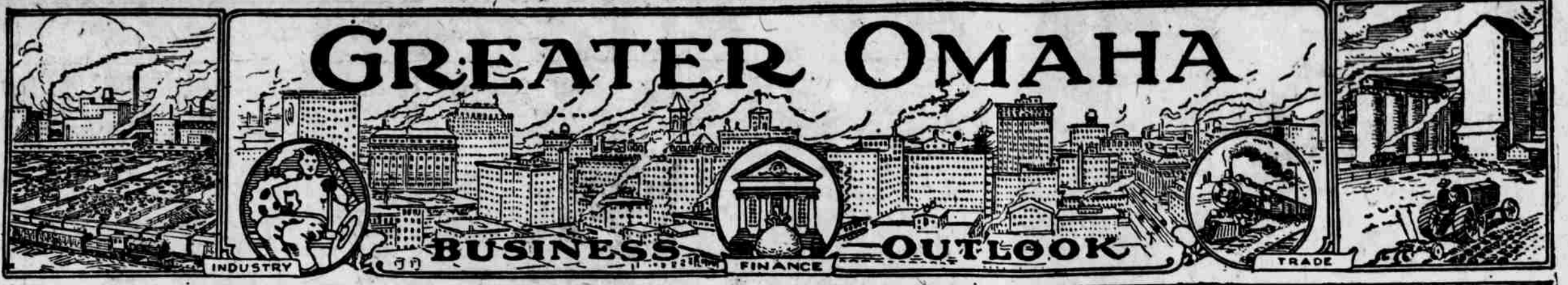
