DO YOU SMOKE MUCH?

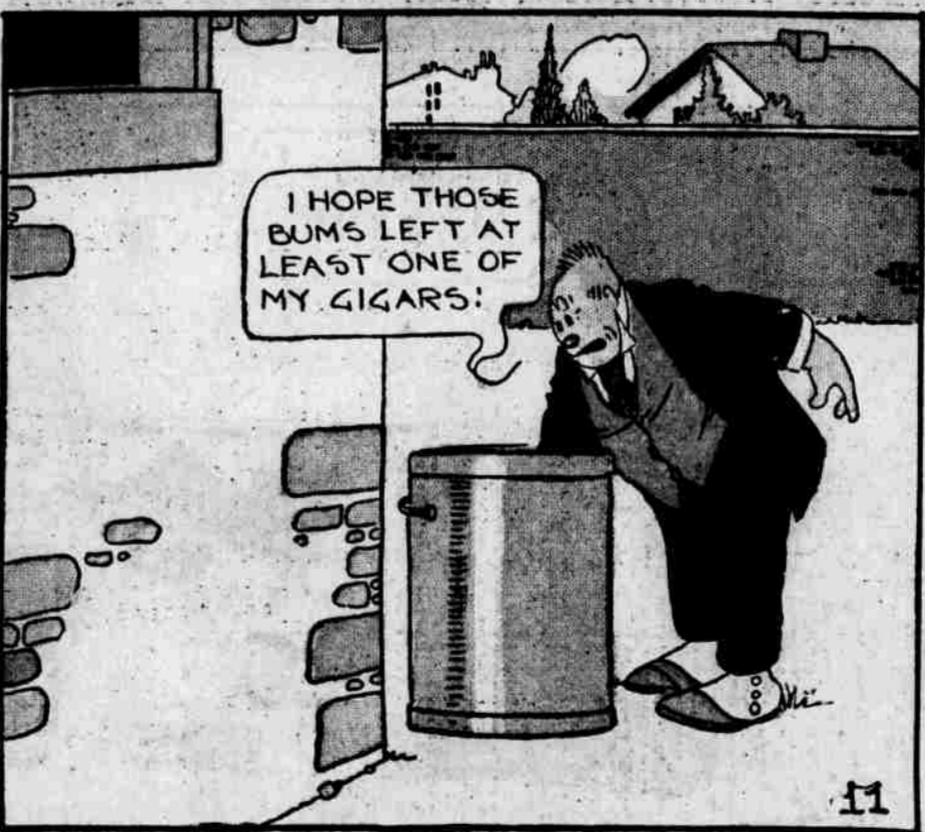

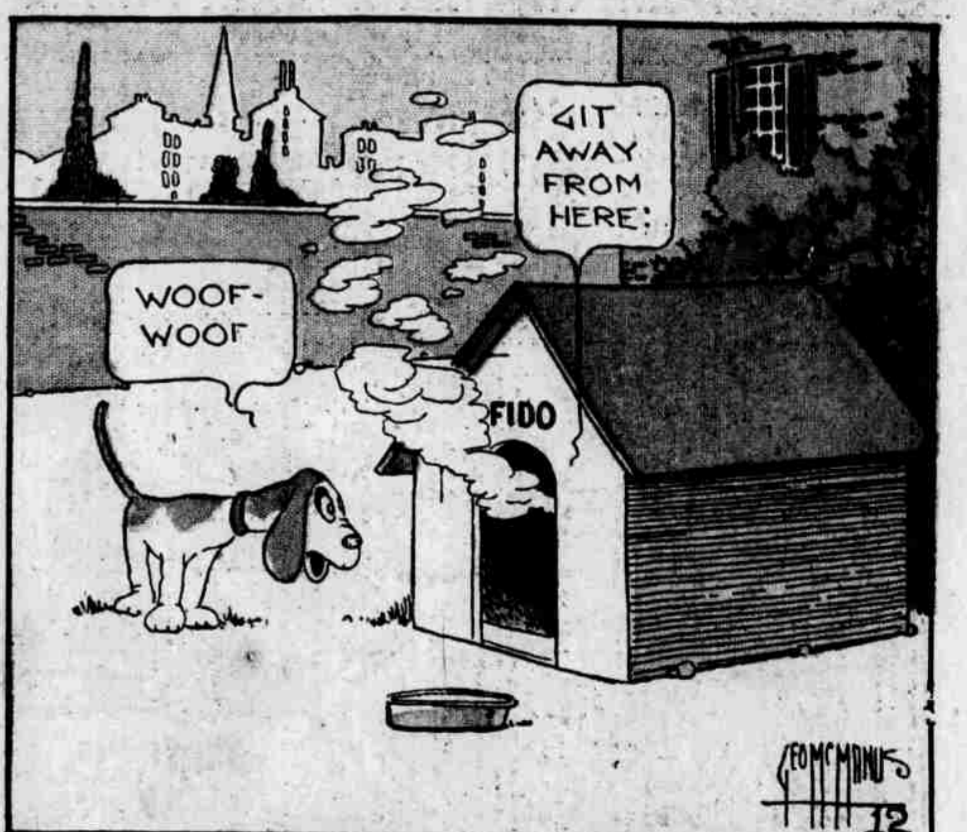
