Albuquerque, N. M., Jan. 2.—From a barren waste of arroyos and wind-swept mountains to fertile plain and grazing hillsides in the transition of the Jicarilla Indian reservation, near Dulca, N. M., in the period of a few short years, since 1916.

In 1916 statistics indicated that the death rate far exceeded the birth rate, and some "experts" even named the date when the Jicarillas would be extinct.

Through the efforts of the Indian commission at Washington the reservation today is a stretch of rich farmland, with hundreds of herds of cattle and sheep grazing on the hill-sides; the redskins are happy and prosperous, and enjoying enlightenment from numerous vocational schools established in the district.
