

South Side THREE MASKED ROBBERS BEAT SOUTH SIDE MAN

"Soaked Me Second Blow for Good Luck," Says Victim, and Took \$120 In Cash.

Peter George, 5211 South Thirtieth street, a packing house employe, was severely beaten and robbed of \$120 at Twenty-third and L streets, at a late hour Saturday night by three masked men with revolvers, according to report made by him to the police Tuesday.

George said he was on his way home, and as he reached the L street corner he was struck from behind and knocked to the sidewalk. Two men sat upon him, while the other went through all his pockets. According to George, one of the men said, "Let's soak him one for luck," and one of the men struck him over the head with the butt of a revolver. The men ran down Twenty-third street. He said he was unable to get up for some time and was assisted to his home by a friend who came along. He was unable to make a report of the robbery until yesterday morning.

On account of the men wearing masks and coming up from behind, George said he was unable to give a description other than they all wore black overcoats and caps and were all about medium build.

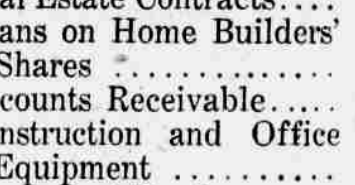
