Constitutional Convention Thursday Will Consider Proposal to Reach Intangible Property.

Lincoln, Neb., Feb. 3.—(Special.) A constitutional proposal for taxing the basis for the Nebraska income tax, which was introduced into the constitutional convention last night, is expected to be one of the items to be considered at the session of the convention on Thursday. The proposal is to reach intangible property, which is a subject that has been discussed in the past but has not been brought to a final vote.

BURLESON SYSTEM OF TOLLS TO BE KEPT IN FORCE

State Commission Wishes to Make Further Study of Situation in Nebraska.

Lincoln, Feb. 3.—(Special.) In an order issued Tuesday, continuing the Burleson schedule of rates and tolls, the state commission on taxation has decided to keep the Burleson system in force until a further study can be made of the toll situation in Nebraska. The Nebraska railroad commission advocates a system of tolls on the basis of "station to station" telephone toll service, which in many cases is shorter than present toll rates.

Permits for Sale Of Three Millions Stock in Nebraska
