If the city takes the plant it must take it as of June, 1918. A plan will have to be worked out, the city probably paying interest on the purchase price from that date and the gas company turning over to the city the profits during that period.
"It is pretty high," was the comment of Mayor Smith when told of the report of the condemnation court. "I believe that \$3.500,000 to \$4,000,000 would have been high

The mayor would not venture a guess on the prospective action of the city council in accepting or rejecting the mains of the court. On a previous occasion the macos said: "If the court allows any go ing value we won't take the plant.


