\$65,000 Church Dedicated. North Platte, Neb., Feb. 7.—(Special.)—Dedication services for the new First Evangelical Lutheran church here will be held all week beginning Sunday morning. The ground was broken for the new building June 4, 1918, and the cornerstone was laid June that year. Building operations were delayed several months, but the church was completed a month ago. It was erected at a cost of \$65,000.
