

UNPRECEDENTED TOURIST TRAVEL WILL TAX ROADS

Union Pacific Officials Declare Transcontinental System Have 70,000 Reservations.

The return of railroads to private management Monday left the passenger traffic department of the Union Pacific railroad with the serious problem of transporting some 40,000 tourists who have been spending the winter in California back to their homes in the eastern and middle-western states.

L. C. Quinn, passenger agent for the Union Pacific, announced yesterday that he had received definite information that the Union Pacific and other transcontinental lines had 70,000 sleeping car reservations from California to the east.

"This eastward movement, which is unequalled in the annals of American railroading, will necessitate the running of three separate sections of the Overland Limited on its east-bound trip," Mr. Quinn said. "The enormous problem of transporting these tourists to their homes in the east may be better understood when it is realized that it practically took all winter to carry these people to California."

"It is true," he said, "that hide prices are very low just now, but there really exists a shortage of hides throughout the country. Manufacturers have laid in their supply of hides in advance and as a result there is no present market for the hides on hand. But they'll go up again as soon as manufacturers really begin to buy necessary stocks."

Cannot Find Market. "Shoes right now are being sold both at wholesale and retail at lower prices than they will have to be sold for later."

"The slump in hide prices could not affect shoe prices for from 10 to 18 months, anyhow," asserted F. G. Hayward, secretary and treasurer of Hayward Brothers, shoe jobbers. "Even a big cut in hide prices would probably be more than offset by increases in things that go into the cost of shoe manufacture."

South Omaha packers and officials of the National Fur and Tanning company, declared they had on hand big supplies of hides for which they were unable to find a market, even at prices from 50 to 68 per cent less than the top market price of last June, when hides sold for 45 and 50 cents a pound.
