

CARRANZA MOVES ARMY TO BE READY FOR A CRISIS

Armed Force, Under Command of Diequez, Reaches Agua Prieta in State of Sonora.

Washington, March 3.—Attention of officials of both the State and War Departments was attracted Tuesday to the Mexican political situation by the reported arrival at Agua Prieta on the northern frontier of the state of Sonora of a "large force" of Mexican troops under General Manuel Diequez.

The army commanded by Diequez was marched from Casas Grandes in the state of Chihuahua. The troops in Sonora are directly accountable to Gov. Adolfo De La Huerta, a partisan of Obregon, who, it was recently reported, had refused to obey an order from Mexico City to demobilize his little army, recruited in the greater part from Yaqui Indians.
