POUCHER DENIES ALL CHARGES IN ALIENATION SUIT

Former Omaha Pastor Even Says He Has No Knowledge Of Hotel He's Said to Have Stopped At.

San Francisco, Cal., March 4.—(Special Telegram.)—Denying emphatically all the allegations of the complaint made by William G. Smeltzer, Rev. John P. Poucher was on the stand practically all day today in the Smeltzer-Poucher \$8,000 alienation suit. His cross-examination was interrupted by adjournment taken until Monday morning. In the afternoon Poucher underwent a severe cross-examination that failed to shake his testimony.

Mrs. Irma Smeltzer, the woman who she was knocked down by the crowd that fought to get front row seats for the afternoon session. She was thrown heavily against the wall and the back of her head severely bruised, but she was able to come into court later although her pallor showed the effect of the rough usage she had received.

Poucher flatly denied charges that he had visited the Hotel St. Mark in Oakland and there written the signature "J. J. Parker and wife, Chicago," that he had held clandestine meetings with Mrs. Smeltzer, taken her on trips to the beaches, used departing train toward her, advised her to leave her husband, in any way interfered between husband and wife.

Admits Meeting Smeltzer. He admitted a brick exchange of words between himself and Smeltzer at the Thorne home in Los Angeles when Smeltzer accused him of undue friendliness with Mrs. Smeltzer, but said that he was at no time afraid of Smeltzer, who is a man considerably larger and younger than Poucher.

Denies Knowing St. Mark. Poucher said that he did not know the location of the Hotel St. Mark in Chicago, and that he had never heard it mentioned until the name was brought out in testimony today.
