Attorneys said they expected to

complete the argument yesterday. Judge Sears may decide at once, they, whether or not to grant an injunction against the paving, or he may take the case under advisement. It is expected that, no matter how the suit is decided, it will be entried to the supreme court.

Judge Sears decided last Friday that the "gentlemen's agreement, signed by the five county commissioners, before the special election of last June in which they pledged themselves to use brick exclusively for paving Douglas county roads, has no legal binding effect.
