Adheres to His Plan of 1914 To Give Ireland One Parliament.

London, March 30 .- Herbert H. Asquith, in the house of commons, described the Irish home rule bill as a "cumbrous duplication and multiplication of institutions and offices," ading that "from the viewpoint of efficiency there is noth-

ing to be said for it." Mr. Asquith recalled that in 1914 he gave a pledge that Ireland should have one parliament and declared that he adhered to that view now, He asserted that the root of the trouble in Ireland could not be go at until there was a wide reform in the government system. Mr. As quith advocated amending the 1914 home rule act, enlarging the powers of the Irish parliament and execu-tive so as to give them to all in-tents and purposes the status of a

Mr. Bonar Law said there were four alternatives. The first was to repeal the home rule act the second.

repeal the home rule act, the second to establish dominion home rule; the third to give self-determination to the Irish people, which would mean an Irish republic, and fourth. to give Ireland the largest measure of home rule compatible with national security and the pledges that had been given. The last, declared Mr. Bonar Law, was what it was intended through the present bill.
